# HIGHLIGHTS OF TATCO 2024 COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES



This program was carried out in two phases i.e February and September 2024 among a number of Nursery and Primary school teachers in our partner schools in Mukono and Kayunga District in a collaboration with *Banga Afayo Community Initiative* that operates in Kayunga.

The aim of this program was to empower teachers with modern skills and methodologies of teaching where **Play Based Learning** was key in the training. Our Theme was "Empower the teacher to empower the learners" which was successfully implemented. Thanks to our strategic sponsor to this program (Global Fund for Children)

#### 2. Women in Business Training 2024







**TATCO** Uganda supported number a community vulnerable women in Mukono and Buikwe District with several business trainings through out the year in Entrepreneurship, Business Management and Financial Literacy with the aim of equipping them with business skills needed to start and run business for economic growth. The project theme was "An empowered woman is an empowered community.

3. Construction of permanent 3 classroom Block at Sunrise N/P School- Nabiyagi





In early 2024, TATCO Uganda was able to construct a permanent 3 Classroom block fully furnished with the needed chairs and tables at Sunrise Nursery and Primary School – Nabiyagi one of our adopted school for development which supports needy children with quality and affordable education. This was aimed at providing a conducive learning environment for the children.

We thank our strategic sponsor for the construction i.e **Classroom for Africa** who made this project successful and making the face of the school more attractive.

## 4.Branding and Modification of Apple Junior School as an ECD center in Bukerere







We were privileged to rebrand and modify Apple Junior School one of our ECD model center in Bukerere.

We did wall branding, provision of some children play equipments both indoors and outdoors that attracts children to learn while playing and helps them to grow mentally and physically.

## 5. Literacy on Wheels and Creation of Literacy Champions







Literacy champions and Literacy on wheels project was started as collaboration with *Lead to Learn Foundation* that trains children between 12-18 years to become Literacy champions who with the support of the bikes move within the community to support children in Literacy and provide reading books.

This was a pilot project for TATCO Uganda in 2024 and it will be carried forward for the growth of Literacy among community children.

## 5. You will pass Primary Leaving Exams 2024 Motivation Tour and Scholastic Material Support







During the period of **Primary** Leaving Examination (P.L.E) for P.7 candidates, **TATCO** Uganda education staff carried out a tour to our partner schools with candidates with the aim of continued academic counseling and guiding the candidates on how to prepare and pass their P.L.E addition to finding and giving them solutions to some of the challenges that might affect their performance.

We also gave them all the needed scholastic materials to help them in the preparation and in the exams.

## 6. Elderly care and support activities 2024







One of TATCO Uganda's community support progams is Elderly care and support where we provide some of the needed items for life to the vulnerable elderly persons and sick in our areas of operation.

In 2024 we cared and supported a number of needy elderly persons with home basic use items which included sugar, soap, rice, posho, salt, teal leaves, clothes, and others in our reach.

We also celebrated with them the International day of the elderly and continued our home visits to give them a ray of hope and courage as our elders.

#### 7. Youth Vocational Training







We continued our support to the youths both girls and boys by giving them vocational skills training in Computer/ICT, Hair Dressing and Tailoring.

We managed to train over 100 youths in the above mentioned vocational skills where Computer training was carried out at our center and the tailoring and hair dressing students taken to partner training centers to be trained where we facilitated them with the necessary materials and training subscription fees. These students are now in the field practicing.

But we hope to build our own fully equipped vocational center

## 8. GFC East African Partners Collaboration to Work and Exchange Visits Program







Our partnership with Global Fund for Children (GFC) since 2022 with our shared goals of supporting Children and Youths shrive has since then had a profound impact on our organization. Because of this we were able to start up a collaboration between partners of GFC in East Africa which include us *TATCO Uganda, Amuno Rural Hub, Implicit Effect Inititative* in Uganda and *Maji Mazuri Community Initiative* in Kenya.



During our first year of collaboration as partners in development, we made exchange visits to each other, shared ideas for capacity development in programming, learnt and explored what we do differently for continued growth and had an end of year staff wellness together in Sagana Kenya.






